Mid-Tier Scheme

- ⇒ Five-year scheme including Land-based (Revenue) Options and Capital Items.
- ⇒ Agreement starting from the 1st January 2023.
- ⇒ Revenue payment rates have increased by approximately 30% from previous years.

Revenue options

Revenue payments relate to the management of field parcels.

Popular options:

 \Rightarrow Low inputs grassland £71/ha - £132/ha

⇒ Management of rough grazing for birds £110/ha

⇒ Enclosed rough grazing for Moorland £43/ha

Supplementary options can be added to these 'base' options to increase annual payments.

Capital Items

Capital items are available within the Mid-Tier Scheme.

Examples of items available include those listed overleaf.

Capital items included are capped & must be completed in first 2 years of the agreement.

Deadline for submitting Mid-Tier applications

approx. 30th July 2022

Capital Grants

- ⇒ 2 year scheme including Capital items only.
- ⇒ Agreements expected to commence from September 2022.
- ⇒ Maximum grant is expected to be capped.
- ⇒ Water Quality items are subject to High & Medium Water Priority areas.

Popular Capital Items:

\Rightarrow	Planting new hedges	£11.60 per metre
\Rightarrow	Stone wall restoration	£25.00 per linear metre
\Rightarrow	Stone wall supplement – Top wiring	£3.60 per metre
\Rightarrow	Stone wall supplement – Stone from quarry	£44 per metre
\Rightarrow	Hedgerow laying	£9.40 per metre
\Rightarrow	Hedgerow coppicing	£4 per metre
\Rightarrow	Hedgerow gapping-up	£9.50 per metre
\Rightarrow	Sheep netting	£4.90 per metre
\Rightarrow	Wooden Field Gate	£390 per gate

Popular High Water Priority:

⇒ Outdoor concrete yard renewal £27.14 per square metre

Roofing £62 per square metre

Capital items under High Priority relate to improving water quality by reducing surface run-off.

CSFO consent is required early for high priority items

Deadline for submitting Capital Grant applications

approx. 30th April 2022
